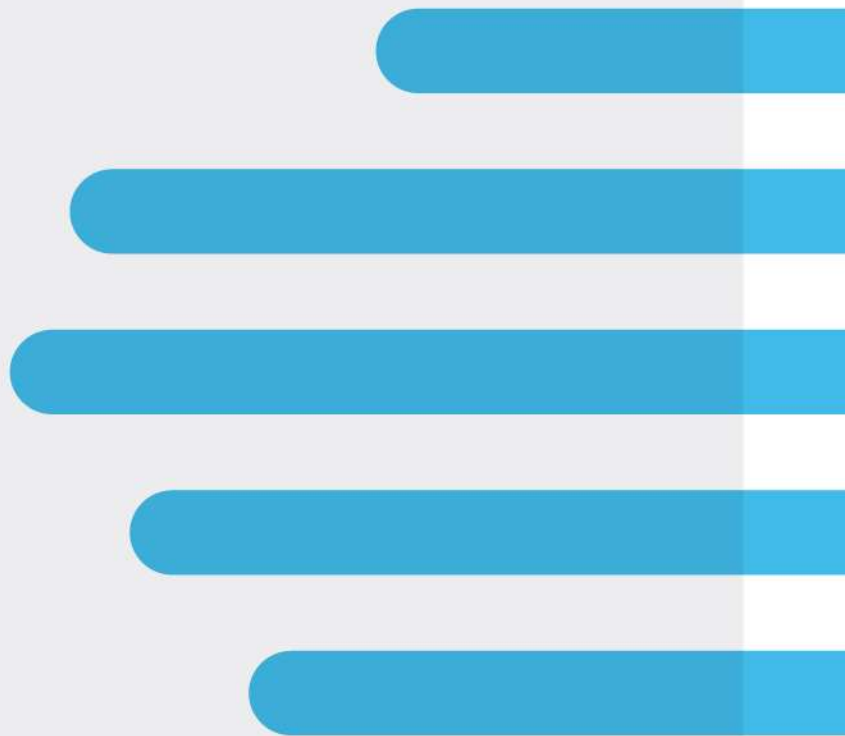

Drug Distributor Licensing Requirements Survey

In the ***Drug Distributor Licensing Requirements Survey***, IQVIA provides a comprehensive picture of wholesale distributor licensing requirements for all 50 states and the District of Columbia. For full topic coverage, we have also included material from the National Association of the Board of Pharmacy (NABP) and from Federal statutes and regulations. The survey includes licensing requirements which address the types of licenses / registrations available for all drug distributors, and a list of statutes and regulations used as authority. The survey addresses such concerns as: Registration / licensure; Surety bond or its equivalent; Authorized distributors of record; Designated representative requirements; Background checks to be done by the licensing authority; Submission of fingerprinting; and Submission of photographs. This information is provided both via quick view charts for ease of use, as well as relevant portions of the text for the statutes and regulations on point.

Drug Quality Security Act Requirements and State Licensing

The ***Drug Quality Security Act Requirements and State Licensing*** survey addresses federal and state postures regarding licensure of third-party logistics providers, in addition to changes in product tracing requirements consistent with the DSCSA requirements and implementation schedules. The survey traces the adoption of third-party logistics provider licensing across the states and their postures with respect to tracking and tracing product. The survey does provide this information in various formats, including charts, at-a-glance summaries for individual jurisdictions, and provides easy monitoring of upcoming changes in the statutes and regulations via a “Pending” chart.

Loss and Theft Reporting Requirements Survey

The ***Loss and Theft Reporting Requirements Survey*** provides information from all 50 states and the District of Columbia regarding reporting requirements for losses or thefts of both legend pharmaceuticals and controlled substances. Information such as reporting timeframes and the agency to whom to report to are broken out in chart form and enumerated individually in the at-a-glance summary sections. The survey also addresses security requirements for warehousing of such substances.

Drug Sampling: Registration, Distribution, and Storage Survey

The ***Drug Sampling: Registration, Distribution, and Storage Survey*** provides information regarding the posture at the state and federal level regarding drug sampling and addresses issues pertaining to both legend pharmaceuticals and controlled substances. Some topics covered are whether mail order sampling is permitted in the jurisdiction, the licensure implications for manufacturers or wholesalers engaged in sampling, and storage of samples. The survey has recently undergone an expansion to include licensing and reporting requirements for individual sales representatives.

Listed Chemicals: Registration, Distribution and Reporting Requirements Survey

The ***Listed Chemicals: Registration, Distribution and Reporting Requirements Survey*** addresses licensing and handling issues for chemical precursors and other Listed Chemical substances across all fifty states and the District of Columbia. The survey provides comprehensive information regarding licensing, recordkeeping, reporting of transactions, and includes other important information regarding additional requirements that may be unique to the jurisdiction.

Wholesale Transaction and Suspicious Order Reporting Requirements Survey

In the ***Wholesale Transaction and Suspicious Order Reporting Requirements Survey***, IQVIA has examined the statutes, regulations, and practices of the fifty states and the District of Columbia to determine and compile affirmative reporting information required for the distribution of Legend Drugs and Controlled Substances. Special attention was given to the reporting of Suspicious Orders, ARCOS-style reporting, and other electronic reports. While the focus of this survey is reports associated with Legend Drugs and Controlled Substances.



Medical Devices License Requirements by State Survey

The ***Medical Devices License Requirements by State Survey*** provides a comprehensive picture of device licensing requirements for all 50 states and for the District of Columbia and includes the texts of applicable law by state, separated out into business model (wholesaler v. direct-to-consumer operations). Information for each state noting key licensure types, fees, where available, and notable licensing nuances of each state is also provided, and information provided also includes drug-related requirements to show exactly which portions apply to device distribution. The survey also addresses: the types of licenses/registrations applicable to device distribution; the categories of devices encapsulated by the licensure types; and provides a list of statutes and regulations used as authority. The document does not address requirements for Medical Device Manufacturers or enrollment requirements for Medicaid reimbursement.
